Ladies and gentlemen, distinguished guests, and hockey enthusiasts welcome to this special evening as we gather to celebrate the esteemed career and outstanding community achievements of Mr. Cal Nichols.

Hosted by the likes of Kevin Karius, Gene Principe, Bob Stauffer, and Mark Connolly, the evening will highlight some of Cal's numerous community contributions. Some recognizable Oilers alumni will also join us in



toasting Cal.

Born in Paradise Hill, Saskatchewan, Mr. Cal Nichols started his oil and gas career as an Esso commission agent. He has spent most of his life in petroleum marketing-related industries and real estate development. In 1984, Cal was a founding partner in Northridge Petroleum Marketing Inc., which became the first privately owned company in crude oil and gas marketing in Canada after deregulation. He created Gasland Oil Ltd. in 1985, which grew to over 50 branded independent petroleum outlets in Western Canada.

Mr. Nichols is best known for spearheading a group of local investors in 1998

to purchase the NHL's Edmonton Oilers Hockey Club and prevent them from leaving the City (twice). Cal went on to serve as Chairman and NHL Governor for ten years. Cal has been inducted into the Alberta Business Hall of Fame and has been recognized by many other organizations for his continued efforts in his community.

In 2014, he was named to the Order of Canada, established in 1967 to acknowledge citizens with "... outstanding achievement, dedication to the community and service to the nation." Mr. Nichols states how worldview was shaped by reciprocity, "I believe in being rewarded for superior effort, harder work, ... you should benefit from that, but in the process of benefiting, you should never forget where you came from, and how can I use my good fortune to help those








THE CAUSE

Advancing Immunotherapy in Alberta

Cancer is a severe threat to anyone unfortunate enough to contract the disease. It's not a comic book villain that a super soldier can easily vanquish. But what if our bodies could be taught to develop super soldier cells capable of destroying cancer? This is what Dr. Michael Chu's made-in-Alberta immunotherapy program aims to do.

Donations raised from the Toast of the Town will go toward building two new state-of-the-art labs and advancing immunotherapy research and treatment in Alberta.

What is Immunotherapy?


Dr. Chu explains, "Immunotherapy is a new way of attacking cancer." This method differs from the traditional treatment options that have been available for the last 50 years: surgery, chemotherapy and radiation. "For cancer to develop, it would have to overwhelm the patient's immune system to begin with," continues Dr. Chu. Immunotherapy aims to reinvigorate the immune system into fighting cancer cells again. However, this idea has had its challenges. "Exciting the immune system means that the immune system has to be capable of recognizing cancer in the first place, which is why there are many variations of immunotherapy," Dr. Chu explains.



What is Car-T Cell Immunotherapy?


Chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy takes the patient's T-cells and genetically manipulates them to add chimeric antigen receptors onto them. This acts as a new barcode reader, helping the T-cell recognize cancer and activating the T-cell. Once the immune system can identify cancer cells again, the host has a better chance of fighting the disease.

CAR T-cells recognizing these cancer cells have led to cures in multiply relapsed acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) and aggressive non-Hodgkin lymphoma (NHL). By utilizing CAR T



Cells, a group of patients who would typically be palliative will have a serious chance.

"CAR T-cell therapy has been able to cure roughly half of the patients that we've been able to give it to, in patients that have no chemotherapy or other treatments available to them," explains Dr. Chu.



What We Do Today Changes Lives Tomorrow

Advances in cellular therapy are evolving quickly, and investment in the proper infrastructure is needed for Alberta to remain leaders in this area, creating more therapies for more patients. The goal is to help fund rapid, high-quality, nimble, safe and cost-effective manufacturing of cell therapies right here in Edmonton.

With your support, funding will go toward:

- Developing a GMP (Good Manufacturing Practice) in-house lab for manufacturing CAR T-cell therapies. This will bring manufacturing closer to the Cross Cancer Institute patients and across Alberta.
- Developing a comprehensive research lab to support ongoing provincial innovation and cellular therapy clinical trials.
